Fractional Currency | Littleton Coin Company Civil War uncertainties led to widespread coin hoarding, so Congress authorized 3¢, 5¢, 10¢, 25¢, and 50¢ fractional notes issued from 1862-1876. Made redeemable for silver coins in 1876, nearly all of these Civil War collectibles were turned in.
